





## # 2305A Tumbling "E" Acuity Sight Test - Chart 2

- Tumbling E charts, also referred to as Illiterate E tests, are useful for testing patients that are illiterate or mute.
- Patients simply have to sign or gesture which direction they see the E facing.
  Tumbling E charts are considered highly reliable and are second only to Landolt C tests.
- Both tests use only one optotype positioned differently and are useful for testing several types of patients.
