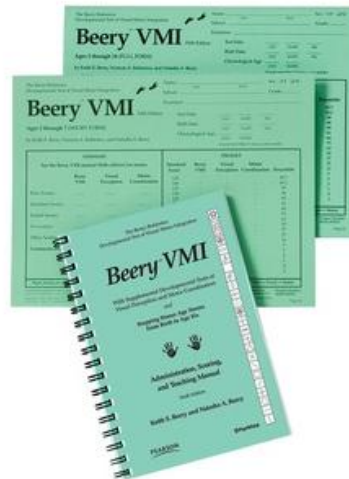

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BEERY VMI Beery-Buktenica Developmental Test of Visual-Motor Integration | Sixth Edition

Short Format and Full Format tests present drawings of geometric forms arranged in order of increasing difficulty that the individual is asked to copy. (The Short Format is often used with children ages 2 to 7 years.)
